	An opportunity to form a local consensus, in a single document, on how the quality of life in Blaxhall might be maintained or improved in the future.
How	will the Parish Plan be used?
	Parish, District and County Councils will use it as guidance on local views.
	Government and other agencies (such as the Lottery Fund) which provide funds for Parish projects may require applicants to provide a Parish Plan as evidence of local support for such projects.
Wha	t are the benefits of a Parish Plan?
	It will provide a snapshot of local views on Blaxhall's amenities, services and housing.
	It will provide a clear indication of Parish feeling regarding specific improvement projects.
	It will support Blaxhall's funding application for the Village Hall refurbishment – the results of the recent village hall survey (which are to be incorporated in the Parish Plan) showed strong local support for improving the facilities in the Village Hall whilst maintaining the character of the existing building.
	It has provided Blaxhall the immediate benefit of a Countryside Agency grant (in excess of £3500) to purchase a photocopier, computer, display boards and other equipment needed to prepare a Parish Plan (this equipment will be donated to the Parish Council upon completion of the Parish Plan).
How	will the Parish Plan be created?
	A group of volunteers from within the village have prepared a pilot questionnaire (overleaf) to provide you with a hopefully easy route to identify those aspects of life in Blaxhall, if any, which you believe require improvement.
	Your opinions are important as the results of this pilot will be used to build a local consensus and to focus attention on those areas requiring more detailed review and action. The detailed review will involve discussions with interested parties and potentially further questionnaires. There will be opportunity for further comment on the Parish Plan before it is finalised and put for adoption to the Parish Council.
